

To parents of Scholastic Bowl players:

Congratulations! Your child is part of our DV Scholastic Bowl team, and is invited to be part of our team as we compete at the National Championship in Atlanta, May 23-27.

Our budget will cover the costs of everything your child needs for this trip, including transportation to and from the airport, the cost of their round-trip flight, their meals and lodging. Since I need to move quickly purchase airline tickets in the name of each of our travelers, I'm writing now to get parental permission for the trip.

Here's the plan. We'll leave from DVHS in the morning of May 28, being driven in a school van to the Airport to get a flight to Atlanta. Once there, we'll go to our hotel, the Atlanta Marriott Marquis. We'll be staying at this hotel and also playing all of our matches at that same site, which is very close to the airport. We'll be competing against excellent teams from all over the nation. We'll return to Delaware Valley on Monday, May 27, and be picked up by a school van to return to DVHS. Your child would be packing for a four-night stay, and our rooms in the hotel should be near to each other.

I'm asking you to consider the above and contact me now if you have any questions. If this meets with your approval, I'm asking you to sign and return this form granting permission for your child to participate in this trip. If you are not granting permission, I would ask that you tell me that quickly so I have a chance to look for a replacement, but I really hope that you will allow this as I believe that the team that we are fielding has a perfect mix of knowledge and team chemistry and lot of potential to do very well against our competition.

Once I get permission for our full team, I will be purchasing the plane tickets immediately in their names. (Note: If your child has a frequent-flyer account with United, please provide that account number with this slip and I'll include it so they can earn their miles.) Photo ID is going to be required at the airport, so please be sure they have that – if your child has a driver's license, they should bring that as their ID. A passport would work, but it's not necessary.
