

- Isaac has Esau and Jacob, Jacob wins birthright and wrestles angel

Leviticus

- Named for Levites, extensive legal practices
- Aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu burned for using "strange fire"
- Priestly and Holiness Codes
- Love thy neighbor, forbidding incest, practice cleanliness

Numbers

- Lists the census of population of the 12 tribes
- Joshua and Caleb only faithful spies (of the 12) that went into Canaan ("Overflowing with milk and honey")
- Balaam mistreats his donkey, begins to talk through angel
- Joshua is successor of Moses
- Phineas kills fornicating couple (Israelite and Midianite)

Deuteronomy (Second Law)

- Law of Moses (Mosaic Law) Love God with whole soul, heart, and might
- "The Lord our God, Our Lord is one" Known as the Shema in Judaism
- Includes Ten Commandments a second time
- Several sermons by Moses and discusses "kosher" food

Joshua

- Siege of Jericho (marched around walls)
- Rahab (a prostitute) helps two spies and leaves a red cord outside her window
- The Sun stood still as Israelites fought
- Crossing of the Jordan River
- Achan and his family stoned after stealing gold after conquest of Ai
- Discusses conquest of Canaan after entering the promised land
- Gibeonites disguise themselves to be pardoned by Israelites
