

Other myths

Egyptian

Horus - falcon headed son of Isis and Osiris.

- Rivalled his uncle Set.
- defeated him in a boat race by making a wooden boat look like a boat of rocks.
- Impaled by Isis and Sobek retrieved his hands with a fishing net.
- Eyes were replaced with sun and moon after Set gouged them out.
- Tricked Set into eating lettuce covered in semen.
- His sons guard canopic jars.

Egyptian

Osiris - killed by his brother Set.

- a fish ate his reproductive organs, which was replaced with a golden set.
- Associated with Apis bull.
- Wears the Atef crown.
- Spine is the Djed pillar.
- Set tricked him into hiding in a pillar.
- Chopped up into 14 pieces, but Isis only regains 13.

Egyptian

Isis - made a clay cobra to make Ra reveal his name. Tried to make a prince immortal but was stopped by his mother. Represented by the tyet.

Set - husband of Nephthys. Hyksos worshipped him at Avaris. Defended Ra's carriage against giant snake Apophis. Associated with greek Typhon. Father of Sobek. Strange animals is Sha.

Ra - born from a lotus flower in primordial sea of chaos. Sekhmet is his eye. Conflated with Atum and Amun. sent cow god Hathor to kill humans.

Thoth- god of wisdom who bet against the moon god to gain moonlight. Poured milk in Horus' eyes.

Norse

Odin - Chief god and husband of Frigg who defeated Ymir with his brother Vili and Ve.

- attacks Fenrir with Gungnir at Ragnarok but will be killed by him, though avenged by Vidar.
- Huginn and Muninn are ravens that keep him informed.
- Lost an eye to the Well of Mimir to gain wisdom and drank the mead of poetry.
- Rides the eight legged horse Sleipnir.
- Gives all of his food to Geri and Freki.
- Owns the self replicating ring Draupnir.

Norse

Odin -

- He can see the entire universe from his throne Hlidskjalf.
- defeats Vafthrudnir in a contest of wits by asking about Baldr.
- had sex with Gunnlod to obtain a glass of mead.
- Tortured by his son Geirrodd.

Norse

Thor - husband of Sif who owns the hammer Mjollnir, the belt Megingjord, and will kill and killed by the Midgard Serpent, whom he lifts in the form of a giant cat.

- Failed to drink an entire cup containing the sea.
- His chariot is pulled by two goats, Toothgrinder and Toothnasher.
- Dressed up like Freya to retrieve Mjollnir from Thrym.
- Father of Modi and Magni.
- Petrified the dwarf Alvis to prevent him from marrying his daughter Thrud.
- Lost a wrestling contest to the elderly Elli.
- Grid helped him kill Geirrod.
- Went fishing with Hymir for the Midgard serpent.
- Forced Thialfi and Roskva his servants after they injure his goats.
- Kills Hrungrnir after he won't leave Valhalla.
- Poisoned by the Midgard serpent after taking steps to kill him.

Norse

Loki - kills and is killed by Heimdallr at Ragnarok.

- Father of Fenrir (with Angraboda), Hel, and the Midgard serpent.
- Mates with the horse Svadilfari to produce Sleipnir while trying to stop giants from building the walls of Asgard.
- Tricked the blind Hodur in killing Baldr, for which is punished by having snake venom drip on him which his wife Sigyn tries to catch in a bowl.
- Killed Fimafeng at a party held by the Aegir.
- Lost an eating contest to fire.
- Tried to stop Brokk and Eitri from making Mjollnir, who sewed his mouth shut.
- Kills Thiazzi with Thor for kidnapping Idunn.
- Fights with Heimdallr in the form of a seal after stealing Freya's necklace Brisingamen.
- Geiroth made him summon an enemy to kill, for which he picked Thor.
- Gave up his ring from Andvari to Otr for killing him.

Norse

Yggdrasil - world tree where Odin hangs himself for nine days to learn runes. The Dragon Nidhogg uses the squirrel Ratatoskr to send messages on this tree. Connects the nine Norse worlds.

Ragnarok - preceded by three winters. Lif and Lifthrasir are humans who populate the earth after it. Heimdallr blows the Gjallarhorn which signifies the beginning of it. Surt sets the world on fire during it after fighting Freyr.

Hinduism

Brahma - creator god with 4 heads after Shiva cut off the fifth.

- Chased his consort Saraswati in the form of a bull.
- Created the first human Manu.
- rides the goose/swan Hansa. Born on a lotus.
- Children are known as the Prajapati.
- Typically depicted with four arms, carrying a water jug, a scepter, a bow or spoon, and the Vedas.

Shiva - destroyer god, husband of Parvati and father of Ganesha and Kartikeya.

- Lingam are phallic statues of him.
- Rides the bull Nandi and resides on Mt. Kailasa.
- His form of Nataraja is a dancer that tramples the head of a dwarf.
- Throat turned blue when he drank poison during the churning of the ocean of milk.
- The ganges is said to flow from his hair.
- Kills enemies with his third eye.
- His Bhairava form is destructive.
- Chopped off Ganesha's head for trying to defend Parvati.
- Wields with trishula Trident.

Hinduism

Vishnu - preserver deity who rides the eagle Garuda.

- Husband of Lakshmi who has 10 avatars.
 1. Matsya is a half-fish who warns Manu about a flood and protects the Vedas.
 2. tortoise Kurma who holds the world during the churning of the ocean of milk.
 3. boar Varaha kills kidnapping demon Hiranyaksha.
 4. half-lion Narasimha kills king Hiranyakashipu who almost killed his son Prahlada.
 5. dwarf Vamana takes three steps to conquer earth, heavens, and underworld, to outwit demon Bali.
 6. axe-wielding Parashurama who kills his companions.
- 9. 9th- Buddha.
- 10. Kalki who rides a white horse and ends the Kali Yuga.

Hinduism

Rama - 7th avatar who is exiled for 14 years by Kaikeyi, the king's wife in favor of Bharata, her son, who keeps Rama's sandals at the foot of the throne.

- He marries Sita following an archery contest but is abducted by the rakshasa Ravana, whom he, his brother Lakshmana, and Hanuman defeat.
- He makes Sita withstand a ring of fire to prove her purity once he recaptures her.
- Rama Navami is a holiday that celebrates his birthday.

Hinduism

Krishna - 8th avatar who is Arjuna's charioteer during the Kurukshetra war in the Bhagavad Gita.

- He proclaims "I am destroyer of all worlds".
- King Kamsa tried to kill him for fear of being killed.
- Tamed a snake polluting the Yamuna river.
- Nursed by the demon Putana.
- He was adored by Gopis including Radha and stole butter

Agni - god of fire

Indra - god of thunder

Aztec

Backstory - five races of man from five different sun eras after defeating the crocodile being. Ometeotl gave birth to four sons.

Quetzalcoatl - feathered serpent god.

- Heart became the morning star after Tezcatlipoca tricked him into having sex with either his sister or a priestess.
- Twin brother was god of dead Xolotl.
- Went to earth and poured blood on old bones in underworld to create modern humans.

Aztec

Tezcatlipoca - monster Cipactli ate his foot and replaced it with obsidian, a black smoking mirror.

- Sent servants to wind god to create music.
- Some stars are his footprints.

- Turned into jaguar **Tepeyollotli**.
- Destroyed world after Quetzalcoatl knocked him out of the sky.

Aztec

Huitzilopochtli - mother Coatlicue was impregnated with a ball of feathers.

- God of sun and war and wields a fire serpent.
- Killed Coyolxauhqui after his sister, the moon, attacked his mother.
- Threw them into the sky to make the stars.
- Name means left handed hummingbird.

Tlaloc - third son and rain god who sent a rain of fire to destroy the world after Tezcatlipoca stole his consort Xochiquetzal.

Shintoism

Izanagi - husband of Izanami, father of Amaterasu (right eye), Tsukuyomi (right eye), and Susanoo (nose).

- Stood on rainbow with Izanami and dipped a spear into the ocean to create Japan.
- Their child Kagutsuchi (fire god) killed Izanami and because she ate in the underworld (Yomi), she couldn't return.
- She killed 1000 people per day while he created 1500.

Shintoism

Amaterasu - sun goddess, grandmother of Emperor Jimmu.

- Hid in a cave after Susanoo threw a flayed horse at her.
- She was lured out by a dancing goddess and a mirror.
- Susanoo annoyed her by killing a goddess of food, and they had a contest where she created men from his sword and he created women from her necklace.
- A shrine that holds a mirror sacred to her is rebuilt every 20 years.

Shintoism

Susanoo - god of seas and storms. Used the sword Kusanagi to make peace with Amaterasu after he obtained it while killing the dragon Yamata no Orochi.

- He turned a woman into a comb to protect her while he killed that dragon.

Ryujin - main sea god and father of Otohime. Crushed the bones of jellyfish after it failed to capture a monkey for him.

Arthurian

King Arthur - son of Uther Pendragon and Igraine and advised by Merlin.

- Father of Mordred with half sister Morgause.
- Wife is Guinevere who had an affair with Lancelot.
- Mordred mortally wounded him at the Battle of Camlann, after which he tried to recover in Avalon.
- Given the sword Excalibur by the lady of the lake.
- Conceived with Uther disguised himself as Gorlois to impregnate Igraine.
- His nemesis, the magician Morgan Le Fay may have thrown Excalibur in a lake.

Celtic

Cuchulainn - born Setanta to Lugh and Deichtine.

- Kills his son Connla after mistaking him for an intruder.
- Wields the spear Gae Bulga.
- Stops the invading forces of Queen Medb from stealing the cow Donn Cuailinge at the Cattle Raid of Cooley.
- Changed his name to Cuchulainn after forcing a ball of leather down the throat of a dog in self defense.

Finn MacCool - father of Ossian and grandfather of Oscar who burnt his thumb while cooking the Salmon of Knowledge.

- Killed the fire breathing demon Aillen.
- Currently asleep and will be woken up by Fianna when Ireland needs help.
